Domenico Cavaiuolo is a Professor of Special Education and Rehabilitation. He also directs the CILLS (Career and Independent Learning & Living) program at ESU. Domenico will stress the importance of early (think from kindergarten!) transition planning. He will share examples of young people who are making smooth transitions to young adult life.
